



# Directory for dardanelle

## LODGING

### BOULDER FLAT CAMPGROUND.

Campsites have flat ground, picnic table, and grill. \$13.00 per camp unit (verify). Place cash in envelope, put in deposit box. Hwy 108.

### BRIGHTMAN FLAT CAMPGROUND.

Campsites have flat ground, picnic table, and grill. \$13.00 per camp unit (verify). Place cash in envelope, put in deposit box. Hwy 108.

### DARDANELLE CAMPGROUND.

Campsites have flat ground, picnic table, and grill. \$18 per day per site, \$26 for double site. Place cash in envelope and put in deposit QboxQ. Any use of campground requires a fee. (Don't park while fishing). Hwy 108, Dardanelle.

### DARDANELLE RESORT.

Resort with cabins, restaurant, general store. RV dump station. Gasoline often available. Hwy 108, Dardanelle.

### EUREKA VALLEY CAMPGROUND.

Campsites have flat ground, picnic table, and grill. Fee is \$16 per day per site. Place cash in envelope and put in deposit QboxQ. Hwy 108.

### FENCE CREEK CAMPGROUND.

Campground is 1/2 mile from Clark Fork Rd. Turn right when you see the sign for the campground (shown in photo). (Road you want to be on is labeled QDead EndQ). Daily fee \$6 per day per vehicle (Aug 08). Camp in designated areas only. Closed to OHVs. Off Clark Fork Rd.

### PIGEON FLAT CAMPGROUND.

Walk-in tent-only campground, with some sites right next to the Stanislaus River. Campsites have flat ground, picnic table, and grill. [fee, how pay?]

## INFORMATION & HISTORY

### BRIGHTMAN RANGER STATION.

Information about area. Closed in winter.

### OLD DARDANELLE BRIDGE.

Historic bridge, built 1933. Hwy 108, near Dardanelle.

### HAYES STATION.

Historic site. From marker: QCompleted in 1860 by innkeeper David Hayes in anticipation of the soon-to-be completed Sonora-Mono Toll Rd. By 1865, with the road completed, wagons, stages, and pack trains used the station as a mail, relay, and rest stop for weary travelers and teamsters ...Q Hwy 108, near Dardanelle.

## RECREATION

### COLUMNS OF THE GIANTS.

Short trail offers closer views of the unusual basalt formations. Has interpretative signs. Hwy 108.

### DOUGLAS PICNIC AREA.

Picnic area with picnic table and grill. Short trail takes you to nice view of Stanislaus River. Rest room (primitive). Hwy 108, near Dardanelle.
